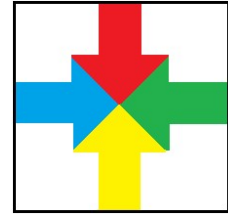

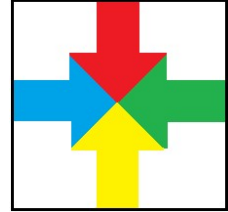

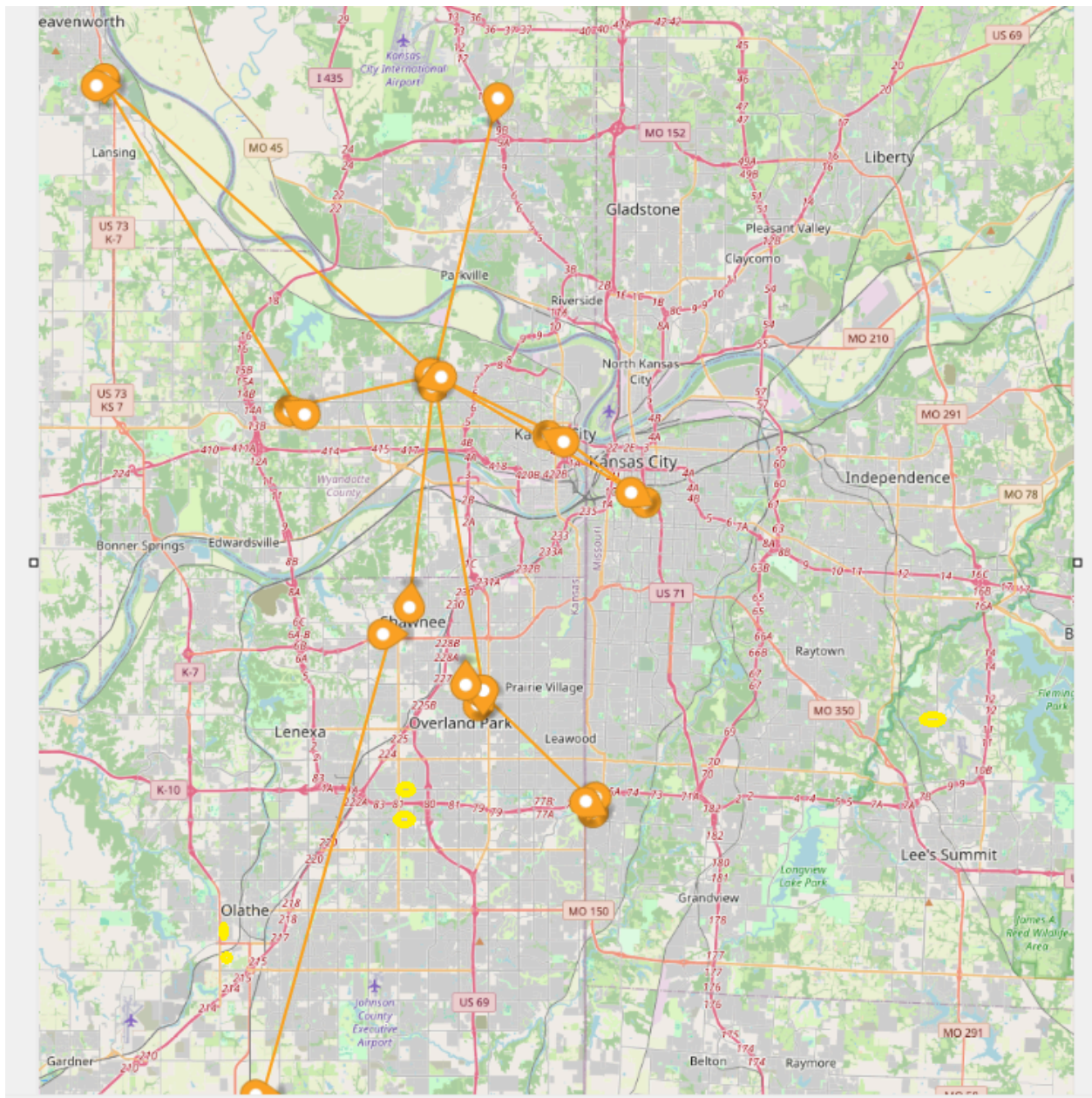

KCmesh 5 GHz Backbone Status Report

Network Overview

- **Total Active 5 GHz Nodes:** 28 Nodes
- **Total Network Nodes:** 64 Nodes (including 2.4 GHz, Supernodes, and Non-RF/Tunnel nodes)
- **Last Map Inventory Update:** 17 July , 10:25 AM

Key Next Steps

1. **Power Up:** Coordinate the activation of the courthouse nodes to bring the Johnson County EOC online.
2. **JCCC Installation:** Deploy the in-hand hardware at JCCC to establish the backbone link required for Overland Park Regional.
3. **Lakewood Deployment:** Schedule scheduling/mounting of the 5G hardware following the successful site survey.
